Challenge Question

If the statue of Thomas Jefferson at the Thomas Jefferson Memorial came to life as the events in this YouTube video unfolded around him, not what would he say but what did he actually ALREADY say about what was going on?

Rationale

To put students into the mind of Thomas Jefferson while bringing him into today's world. Requiring students to use quotes actually attributed to Jefferson will force them to be specific in what they look and listen for in a primary source video as well as be able to apply meaning to Jefferson's words to that video. This lesson would most likely fit in best at some point after students already have some understanding of Jefferson's beliefs.

Steps
